
BUSINESS INVESTMENT IN NORTH CAROLINA

Over the last decade, foreign direct investment has been a key driver to our state's strong economic growth. North Carolina is the 9th most populous state in the US, and has a GDP of \$767 billion which is roughly equivalent to Switzerland's. More than 1,700 foreign firms call North Carolina home, 550+ of which have announced new or expanding projects over the last 10 years bringing in over 59,000 new jobs and \$36.2 billion in capital investment.

Korean businesses continue to choose North Carolina for their North American operations. There are 21 Korean firms with operations in North Carolina, and since 2014, eight Korean firms have announced new facilities or expansions creating nearly 700 new jobs and \$149,312,146 in capital investment.




